

CAN GUESTS BOOK ONE BED IN AN EIGHT BED MIXED DORM AT THE WHITE TULIP HOSTEL AMSTERDAM

Yes, you can book an individual bed in an eight bed mixed dormitory room at The White Tulip Hostel Amsterdam. We list these beds as part of our room options, and guests book a bed in a shared room. It is important to check live availability and current conditions for your specific dates when making a reservation. How does booking a bed in an eight bed mixed dormitory work?
